History

George, Duke of Cambridge (1819 - 1904), grandson of King George III, Field Marshal and Commander-in-Chief of the British Army is interred here with his morganatic wife, Sarah (Louisa) Fairbrother (1815 - 1890). Their three sons, Col. George William Adolphus Fitzgeorge d. 1907, Rear Admiral Sir Adolphus A Fitzgeorge d. 1922, and Col. Sir Augustus Charles Frederick Fitzgeorge d.1933 also rest in the mausoleum as do two children born before their marriage: Charles Manners Sutton Fairbrother d.1901 and Louisa Catherine Hamilton d. 1919.
